- They will go through all or some of the N.T. texts listed below. The texts record the sayings of Jesus about himself.
- Participants will read and consider the entire passage where the statement is found. It is against the background of the entire passage that the statement has to be studied and prayed upon.
- After they read, considered, and pondered the passage that they will pray to Jesus for the grace; **to know Him more, to love Him more dearly and to follow him more closely.**
