They will go through all or some of the N.T. texts listed below. The texts record some of the sayings of Jesus about himself.

The participants will read the texts, comment on them, should any point arise, and pray with them.

- John 6:35 & ff "I am the bread of life".
- John 8:12 & ff "I am the light of the world"
- John 8:58 & ff "Before Abraham was born I am"
- John 10:14 & ff "I am the good shepherd...  
I know my sheep".
- Luke 10:22 & ff "My Father has given me all things...  
No one knows the Father  
except the Son".
- Mathew 11:28 & ff "Come to me all you... and learn  
from me for I am gentle and  
humble of heart".
- John 10:27 & ff "I give them (my sheep) eternal life".
- John 10:30 & ff "The Father and I are one".
- Matthew 12:41 & ff ".. and there is something here, I tell  
you, greater than Jonah...  
greater than Solomon".
- John 11:25 & ff "I am the resurrection and the life...  
whoever believes in me will live,  
even though he dies".

- John 14:6 & ff “I am the way... the truth and the life... no one goes to the Father except by me”..
- John 14:10 & ff “I am in the Father and the Father is in me”.
- John 15:1 & ff “I am the real vine and my Father the Gardener”.
- John 15:5 & ff “I am the vine you are the branches”.
- John 16:33 & ff “I have overcome the world”.
- John 8:28 & ff “When you lift up the Son of man, you will know that I am who I am!”
- John 8:29 & ff “I always do what pleases Him”.
- Matthew 20:28 & ff “I came to serve, not to be served, and to give my life as a ransom for many”.
- Luke 19:10 & ff “The Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost”.
- John 12:32 & ff “When I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw all men to me”.
- John 12:47 & ff “Whoever hears my message and does not obey it, I will not judge him. I came not to judge the world but to save it”.
- John 10:10 & ff “I have come that they might have life, life in all its fullness”.
