Aims of this Exercise

- ✓ To know our Lord Jesus better
- ✓ To love Him more deeply.
- \checkmark To follow im more closely.

PROCEDURE;

- **<u>Relax</u>...** (Some breathing and/or awareness exercises will help).
- > **<u>Be quiet for a while</u>**... Close your eyes...
- Read this text twice very slowly and reflectively
- Fantasize
 - Imagine you are in the countryside. The place is quiet and peaceful... The time is noon...
 - All of a sudden you see Jesus walking by... Look at him... How does he look? You feel irresistibly attracted to him...
 - You get up... run to him... stare at him He stares at you...
 - <u>Ask him: Master, where do you live? Where do you put up?...</u> <u>He replies</u>: <u>Come and see:</u> ... <u>Go with him...</u> See the place where he stays... Spend the rest of the day with <u>him...</u> Keep listening attentively to all he tells you...

<u>Then, time and again, keep asking Him, the same quesstion</u> "<u>Master. Who are you?...</u>

- <u>Ask him</u>: "<u>Master. Who are you?...</u> <u>Jesus rplies</u>. <u>I am the light of the world</u> " (Jn 8:12 & ff) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- 2. <u>Ask him: again "'Master. Who are you?...</u> jesus replies : <u>I am the good shepherd... I know my sheep</u>". (Jn 10:14 &ff) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- 3. <u>Ask him: again ""Master. Who are you?...</u> <u>Jesus replies</u>" <u>Come, and learn from me for I am gentle and humble</u> <u>ofheart"</u>. (Mt. 11:28 & ff) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words

- 4. <u>Ask him: again "'Master. Who are you</u>?... <u>Jesus replies</u>; "<u>I give them - *my sheep* - eternal life". (</u>Jn 10:27 & ff) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- 5. <u>Ask him: again "'Master. Who are you</u>?... <u>Jesus replies</u> : "<u>The Father and I are one</u>". (Jn 10:30 & ff) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- 6. <u>Ask him: again</u> "<u>Master. Who are you?...</u> Jesus replies: "<u>I tell you,there is something here, greater than</u> Jonah...greater than Solomon".)(*Mt* 12:41 & ff) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- 7. <u>Ask him: again</u> "<u>Master. Who are you?...</u> <u>Jesus replies</u> : <u>"I am the resurrection and the life... whoever believes in me</u> <u>will live, even though he dies</u>". (*Jn 11:25 & ff*) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- 8. <u>Ask him: again ""Master. Who are you?...</u> <u>Jesus replies: "I am the way rhe truth and the life "</u> (John 14:6 & ff) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- 9. <u>Ask him: again "Master. Who are you?...</u> Jesus replies : "I am in the Father and the Father is in me. ... no one goes to the Father except by me". (Jn 14:10 & ff) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- **10.** <u>Ask him: again</u> "<u>Master. Who are you?...</u> <u>esus replies: "I am the real vine and my Father the Gardener</u> (*John15:1 & ff*) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- **11.** <u>Ask him: again</u> "<u>Master. Who are you?...</u> <u>Jesus replies</u>: "<u>I am the vine you are the branches</u>". (*Jh* 15:5 & *ff*) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- **12.** <u>Ask him: again</u> "<u>Master. Who are you?...</u> <u>Jesus replies</u>: "<u>I have overcome the world".</u> (*Jn 16:33 & ff*) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- **13.** <u>Ask him: again "'Master. Who are you?...</u> <u>Jesus replies</u>: "<u>I always do what pleases Him".</u> (*Jn* 8:29 & *ff*) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words

- 14. <u>Ask him: again "'Master. Who are you?...</u> Jesus replies: <u>''I came to serve, not to be served, and to give my life as a ransom for many</u>". (Mt 20:28 & ff) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- 15. <u>Ask him: again</u> "<u>Master. Who are you</u>?... <u>Jesus replies</u>: "<u>The Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was</u> <u>lost".</u> (*Lk 19:10& ff*) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- 16. <u>Ask him: again</u> "<u>Master. Who are you?...</u> <u>Jesus replies</u> "<u>When I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw all men to</u> <u>me".</u> (*Jn12:32 & ff*) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- 17. <u>Ask him: again "Master. Who are you?...</u> <u>Jesus replies:</u> <u>"Whoever hears my message ad does not obey it, I will</u> <u>notjudge him. I came not to judge the world but to save it</u>". (*Jn 12:47 & ff*) Read the passage, reflect and pray on Jesus words
- **18.** <u>Ask him: again "Master. Who are you?...</u> <u>Jesus replies:</u> <u>"I have come that they might have life, life in all its fullness</u>" .(*Jn 10:10 & f*)

- 1. The participants will meet in small groups
- 2. They will go through all or some of the N.T. texts above they reflected upon and prayed on
- 3. Comment on them, share and discuss their experiences, feelings and learnings
- 4. Recite St. Bernard's sprayer to Jesus <u>Jesus, the very though of Thee</u>
